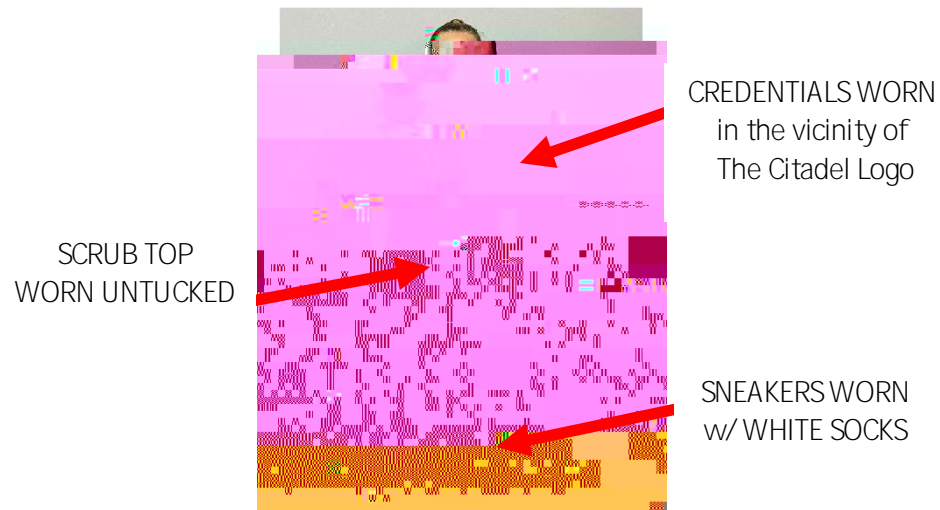


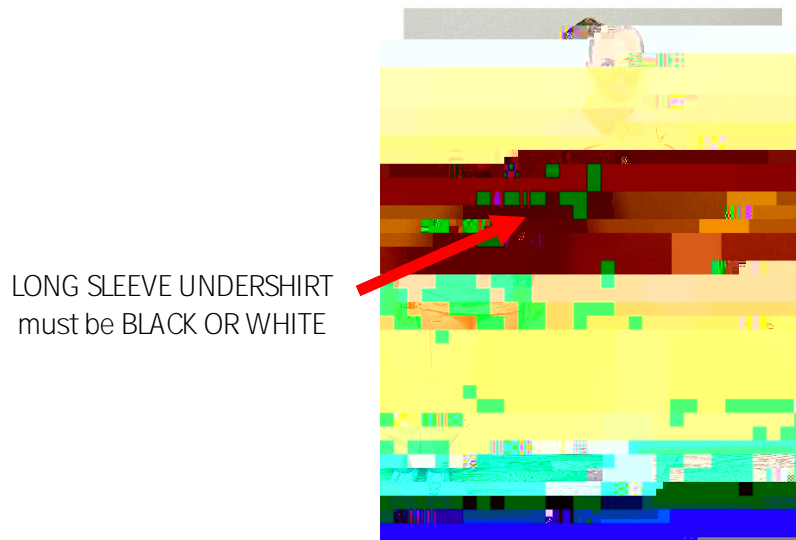
ANNEX M- Nursing Scrubs (July 20, 2024)

A. Nursing Scrubs

1. Authorization for Wear: Cadets in the Nursing program are only permitted to wear nursing scrubs as directed by the school of nursing for the purpose of attending class in clinical settings at designated Health Care facilities on campus as well as designated classrooms on campus. Nursing scrubs may be worn in the Mess Hall during Breakfast and Lunch meal times. Nursing scrubs are not permitted to be worn in any auxiliaries, Mark Clark Hall or academic buildings not specified for the Nursing program.



2. Composition: All White Book grooming standards apply while wearing scrubs.
 - i. Male cadets must wear a undershirt under the scrub top.
 - ii. When long sleeve undershirts are worn under the scrub top it must be black or white.



- iii. Warming layers as authorized by the school of nursing can be worn at the discretion of the cadet and do not have to coincide with the uniform prescribed for the Corps of cadets.
